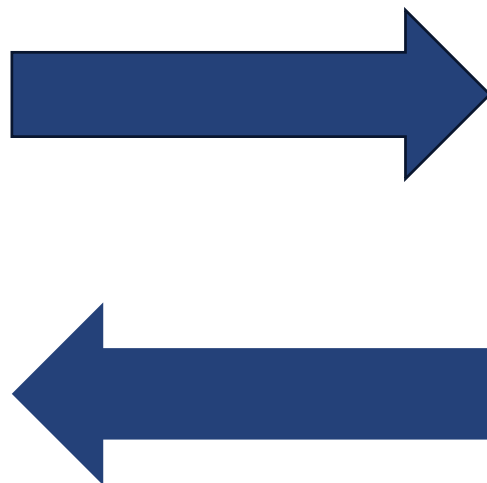

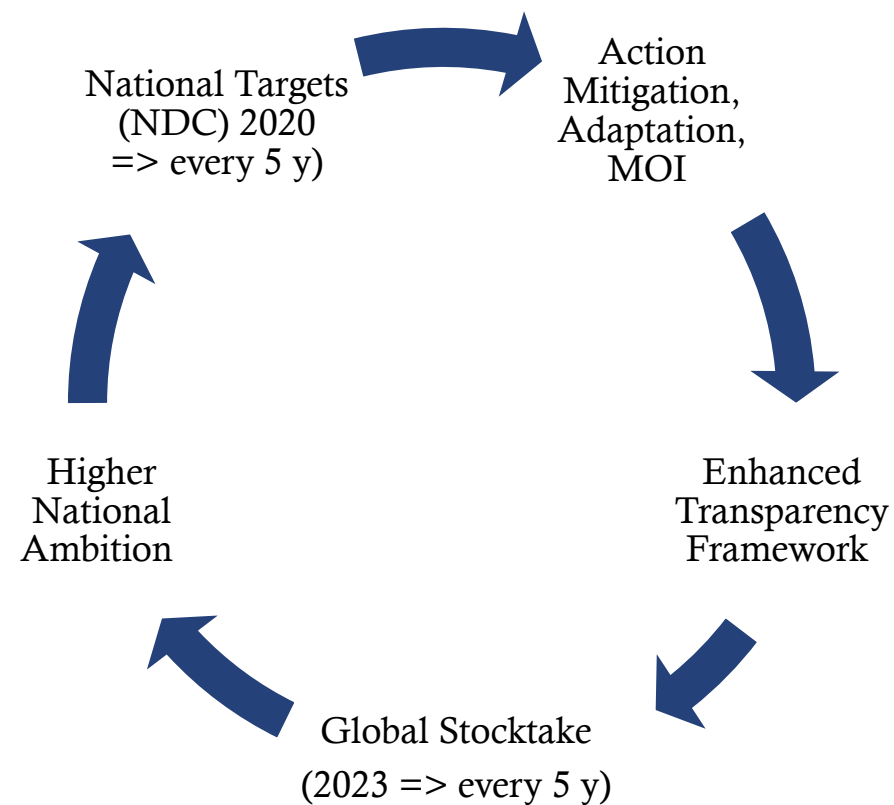

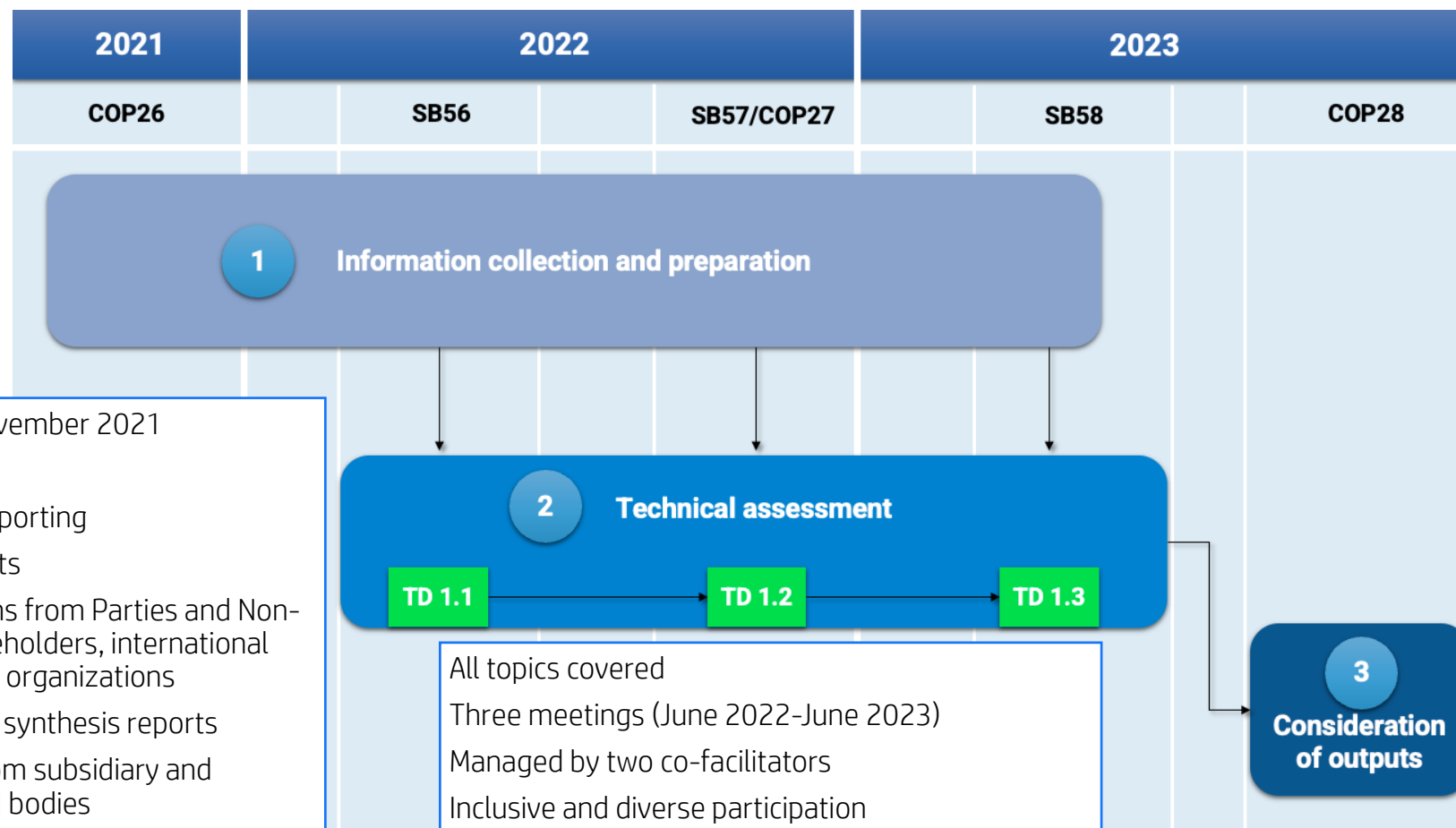


Ambition Cycle



Global Stocktake - How?

Consists of three components:



Started November 2021

National reporting
IPCC Reports
Submissions from Parties and Non-Party Stakeholders, international and regional organizations
Secretariat synthesis reports
Reports from subsidiary and constituted bodies

All topics covered
Three meetings (June 2022-June 2023)
Managed by two co-facilitators
Inclusive and diverse participation
Prepared 3 summary reports and final factual synthesis report (17 key findings)

High-level events at CMA5
Identify opportunities and challenges in enhancing action and support as well as possible measures and good practices and international corporation
Summarize key political messages, including recommendations for strengthening action and enhancing support



Mitigation

- Global emissions are not in line with modelled global mitigation pathways
- More ambition in action and support is needed in implementing domestic mitigation measures
- Systems transformations required across all sectors
- Just transitions can support more robust and equitable mitigation outcomes
- Economic diversification key to address the impacts of response measures

Adaptation

- Increased adaptation action urgently needed
- There is increasing ambition in plans and commitments
- Be informed and driven by local contexts, populations and priorities
- Urgent actions needed to minimize and avert loss and damage
- Scale up support and finance

Mol

- Scaled-up mobilization and support for climate action
- Making financial flows consistent with low GHG emissions and climate resilient development
- Deployment of cleaner technologies
- Capacity building key for sustained efforts

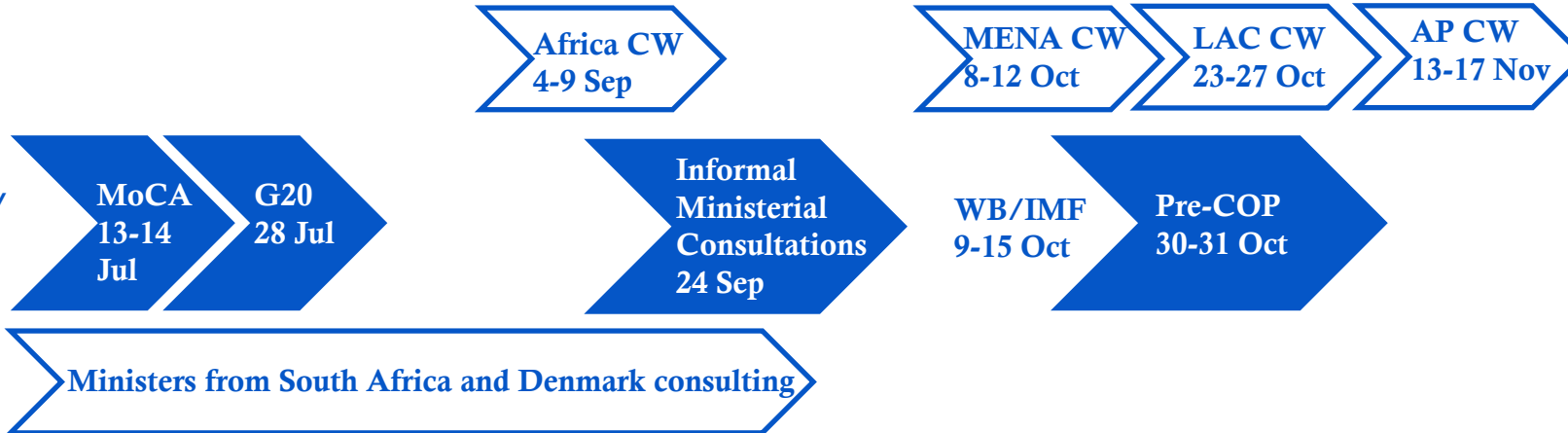

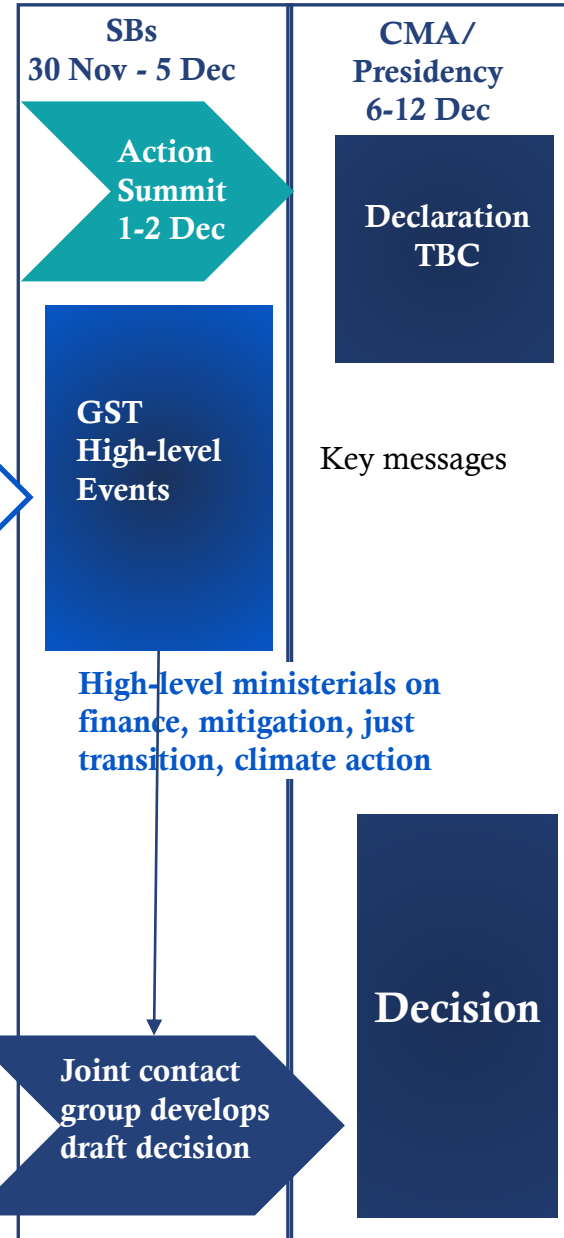

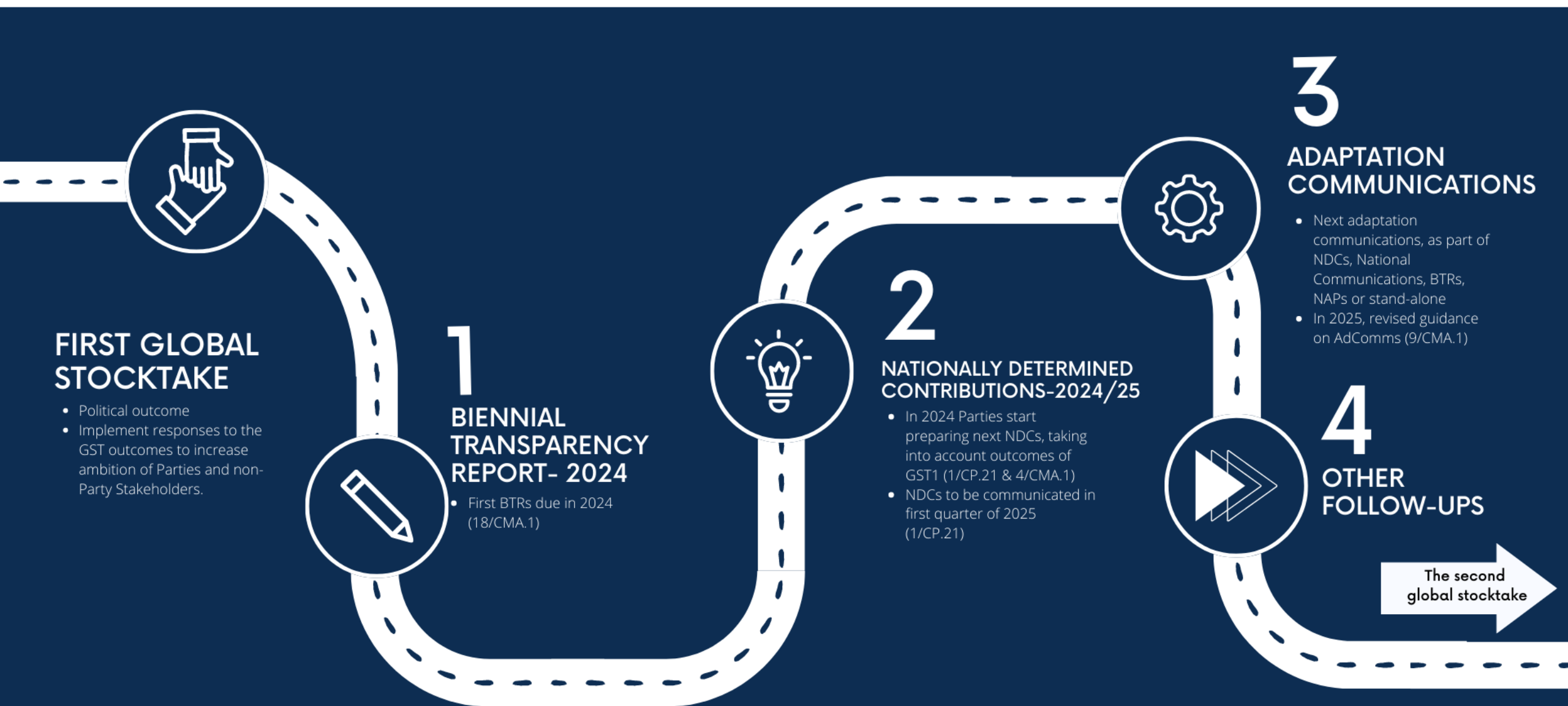

Critical elements for the Global Stocktake outcome

- **Elements for the global stocktake outcome** on thematic areas; Recommendations, guidance, targets, policy priorities
- Informing the update of and strengthening of ambition through plans and strategies—particularly **NDCs**
- **Synergies and linkages with other global priorities**, particularly sustainable development goals, and just transitions.
- Underlying considerations:
 - Latest **scientific** findings
 - **Non-Party stakeholders** engagement
 - **Equity** considerations
 - Beyond COP 28



FOLLOW UP – SOME ACTIVITIES ALREADY AGREED BY PARTIES



FIRST GLOBAL STOCKTAKE

- Political outcome
- Implement responses to the GST outcomes to increase ambition of Parties and non-Party Stakeholders.

1 BIENNIAL TRANSPARENCY REPORT- 2024

- First BTRs due in 2024 (18/CMA.1)

2 NATIONALLY DETERMINED CONTRIBUTIONS-2024/25

- In 2024 Parties start preparing next NDCs, taking into account outcomes of GST1 (1/CP.21 & 4/CMA.1)
- NDCs to be communicated in first quarter of 2025 (1/CP.21)

3 ADAPTATION COMMUNICATIONS

- Next adaptation communications, as part of NDCs, National Communications, BTRs, NAPs or stand-alone
- In 2025, revised guidance on AdComms (9/CMA.1)
